There is therefore no condemnation
To those who are in Christ Jesus
Rom8:1a

Condemnation takes on many forms:

- 1. False beliefs: Thinking that I need someone or something to be happy.
- 2. Comparing yourself with other people: I am not as spiritual as so and so. Or I am not as witty etc.
- 3. Looking to the past: Guilt over past mistakes and sins.
- 4. Looking to the future: Insecurities about what will happen 5 hours or five days from now and thinking that I do not have the resources to cope with it.
- 5. Thinking you have to be somebody: I have to be approved, successful, popular, and wealthy, appreciated.

The mechanism for coping with condemnation is awareness. It is recognizing that unhappiness is in your head, in your thinking, in your conditioning, and not in reality. If you walk in the Spirit and not fulfill the lusts of the flesh you will be free, aware, and alive. Set your mind on things above, where Christ sits at the right hand of God.... For you are dead and your life is hid with Christ in God. Col3:1-3. Be Christ conscious and free.

Awareness 5/28/09 George Poulo Hebrews 3:12-19

While it is said, To-day if ye Will hear his voice, harden not Your hearts.... Heb3:15

1. To see is to love; to be present is to love; to hear is to love. How do we do this?

2. Addictions harden the heart. We only see, acknowledge, and hear what will get us our fix.

3. Fear can harden the heart. We only see, acknowledge and hear what

we are consumed with by our fear.

4. Luke 14; 16-27 Attachments can harden the heart. Possessions (Land), people (wife), and oxen (business, money, power) can harden the heart.

How do we break this stranglehold? By awareness. Seeing ourselves doing this and allowing God, the Holy Spirit to swallow it up. By spending time looking at Nature: flowers, trees, sky, sea, birds, and animals. By repentance. By prayer and fasting. By getting into the word of God. By love

Only Joshua and Caleb entered the Promised Land from the first generation. The belief system of the first generation prohibited these people from walking by faith. They could not operate from the Spirit even though they had manna, the Law, Moses, and God manifesting himself by a cloud by day and a fire by night.

The second generation did not have the baggage of the past. They did not live in slavery or bondage or fear. They did not worship false gods. They were able to live by faith (The just shall live by faith. Hab2:4)

Most of us have grown up like the first generation. Are we doomed to be like them, seeing the Promised Land but not able to enter? The answer is no. Pentecost provides the Spirit living inside of us to help us on our journey. Not only do we need anointed preaching, teaching, and healing ministries, we need to be transformed by the renewing of our minds. The inner being, the inner man, delights in God's law. When we are born-again and filled with the Holy Spirit, we delight in God's law. We wish above all things to do the will of God and by all means, keep from sinning. Yet we fail. There is a law of the flesh, a law of sin that works within my members so strong that I fail to do the will of God. With the mind I am a slave of God's law but with the flesh, the slave of sin. St. Paul goes on to say in Romans 8:1 that because of this flesh bent, there is no condemnation. We try to do well but we fail. How do we overcome this flesh, this sin nature?

The first thing we learn is that we have to crucify this flesh Romans 6). We have to mortify the deeds of the flesh (Colossians 3). We do this by faith. What we confess we receive. We have to hear the word by confessing the word because faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17) In fact faith in anything comes by hearing

what you confess. So start by confessing the word of God and line up your thinking and desires with that word. Be not conformed to the world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind that you may prove the perfect will of God. (Romans 12:2)

Secondly we learn from Romans 8:2 that the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made us free from the law of sin and death. The work of the Spirit is to inhabit this flesh to make it conform to the law of the Spirit. Consequently we need to be baptized into the Spirit so that the Spirit can operate on our flesh to make it conform to the perfect will of God. We need to yield, yield to the Spirit. We need to surrender and die to self so that the efficacy of the Holy Spirit can operate on the flesh.

Third we need to fill our lives with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs and shun the world as much as possible. Television, movies, books, magazines, the internet, all that is of the flesh must be abandoned if it does not have Christ as its center.

Fourth we must not forsake the assembling of ourselves together.

Associate with the right crowd. Avoid bars and discos and the like that drive the flesh to sin. Maintain good Christian friendships and avoid the occasion of sin.

Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him. James 1:12

Fifth, learn from your trials. It is through trials that we grow, build faith, and become a blessing to others.

Fight the good fight of faith. Don't condemn yourself when you fail.

Develop good habits. Follow the Spirit. Amen
